Exemptions:

1) Medical: doctor must state "medically harmful or injurious to health & well-being of child" yearly, unless "lifelong".

2) Reasons of conscience (religious belief good for 2 yrs).

\*Note: Child has to meet guideline of birthdate (ex. 1 yr of age, 4 yrs of age) but has a 4 day leeway before the age specified.
